



FREE MEDIA LITERACY WORKSHOPS!

MNN Youth Channel offers on-site media literacy workshops to after-school programs and community-based organizations. The workshops are offered free of charge and will be facilitated by YC Peer Trainers. Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis and are scheduled on a first come first serve basis.

REQUIREMENTS

- At least 8 youth must be in attendance (and no more than 20)
- Participating youth should be between the ages of 12-23
- A staff-member from your organization must be present
- THERE ARE NO TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS (We will provide all of the necessary equipment and materials)

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

1. Who's in Control? Mind over Media

In this two-hour interactive media literacy workshop, participants will have a chance to think critically about the media we consume everyday. Through a series of large and small group discussions, interactive activities, video clips and photographs, participants will explore the following issues: media advertising; ownership and content; media consolidation; identity and representation; and the central role media plays in democratic societies. Participants will also learn about public-access television and the growing field of Youth Media.

2. PSA-in-a-Day

In this two-hour hands-on production workshop, participants will use video cameras and their collective creativity to create public service announcements (video messages). The session begins with an overview of media literacy and the language of video including camera shots, points of view, and cuts. After breaking into groups, participants will work together to brainstorm ideas, storyboard the shots, and shoot their PSAs. The finished pieces are then screened back to the group. [disclaimer: this workshop is not intended to create broadcast quality videos]

3. YC Animation

Using stop-motion animation is one more way to uniquely work with video... and it's fun! This workshop is an introduction to lo-tech stop-motion techniques. Working in small groups, participants will create separate parts to one animated story. In the process, participants will learn what it takes to make a short video – frame-by-frame. The finished project will be posted on the YC blogspot.
